The Trust held the annual Clinical Audit and Research Competition yesterday, showcasing high standards of work across the Trust. The event was attended by over 100 staff of all levels as part of their monthly educational half days, and the judging panel included Susan Acott - Chief Executive, Mr James Smith – T&O Consultant, Dr Garryk Tan – Consultant Radiologist and Dr Zac Belagodu – Consultant Anaesthetist.

The winner of the Clinical Audit Competition was Dr Charles Godavitarne for his re-audit of orthopaedic weekend handover review of patients who have undergone hip or knee replacement or surgery for fractured neck of femur.

The Research Competition was won by Mr Marco Bolgeri for the evaluation of neutrophil gelatinase-associated lipocalin (NGAL) as a biomarker of renal injury in patients with uretic stones.

The judges were unanimous in their decision and highlighted the importance of the winning projects in terms of enhancing the quality of care given to our patients.
